Teaching methods These will include demonstrations by tutor; individual practice by student; instruction on a group and individual basis.	
Equipment items required over period of course include: Watercolour paints, soft brushes, 2 large pots for water, mixing palette, watercolour paper (size A4 140lb (300gsm), 'NOT' (or cold pressed) surface), 2B pencil, rubber, sketch pad, a variety of soft brushes to include a flat (square ended) ½". Newspaper or plastic table cloth to protect table, apron or similar to protect clothes. Water soluble graphite pencils, a set of good quality soft water soluble coloured pencils (Derwent watercolour pencils or Caran D'Ache water soluble pencils). Drawing pen or dip pen and black Indian ink and an ink/pen that is water soluble, drawing paper, masking fluid, masking tape, ruler.
