For the first session please bring watercolour paints, A3 cartridge drawing pad, good quality 'Bockingford' watercolour paper (size A4 140lb (300gsm), 'NOT' (or cold pressed) surface), a variety of **soft** nylon watercolour brushes, 2 large pots for water, wax crayons or oil pastels drawing pen/biro, pencil (2B), note book, **newspaper or plastic table cloth to protect table**, apron or similar to protect clothes.
