<b>Items you will need to bring to the course</b> Acrylic paints, paper/board/canvas suitable for acrylic paints (size A4/A3), various sized nylon and bristle brushes, palette knife, sponge, old credit card (to cut up), plastic palette or large old china plate, 2 water pots, water spray bottle, masking tape, kitchen towel, pencil (HB), sketch pad, drawing board if you have one, apron, rags, <b>newspaper or plastic table cloth to protect tables</b> and any acrylic equipment you have already. <b>Packed lunch.</b> <b>Optional equipment;</b> stay-wet palette, tear-off disposable palette.	
<b>Additional costs</b> e.g. materials supplied by tutor: None.
