By the end of the workshop, you will be able to employ warm and cool colours to create distance in a painting and create tonal contrast and tonal 'patterns' to create distance and enhance composition.

Teaching methods

These will include demonstrations by tutor; individual practice by student; instruction on a group and individual basis; question and answer, etc.

Items you will need to bring to the course

Set of water-based paints (watercolour, gouache or acrylic). To include orange and Sap green and dark colours such as Alizarin crimson, Prussian blue, Burnt umber, violet. Other useful colours (if you have them) include: Perylene violet, Perylene green, Sepia, Cobalt turquoise light and Green gold (Winsor & Newton Artist's range), brushes and paper suitable for your chosen medium, 2 pots for water, palette, drawing board, masking tape, sketch pad, 2B pencil, rubber, ruler, plastic cover to protect tables. Any other painting equipment you have. Own reference material, photos of landscapes, seascapes, trees, etc. that are dramatically lit. Bring your own packed lunch and drink. NB Suitable equipment to paint outside if required: easel, sun hat, sun lotion, etc.
