Teaching methods

Items you will need to bring to the course

Set of water-based paints (watercolour, gouache or acrylic), brushes and paper suitable for your chosen medium, 2 pots for water, palette, drawing board, masking tape. Ink, any you have already such as fountain pen ink (black Parker Quink), acrylic Sepia ink, Winsor & Newton inks, etc., dip pen, granulation medium (if you have any) for use with watercolours, sketch pad, 2B pencil, rubber, ruler, plastic cover to protect tables. Any other painting equipment you have. NB I'll have some inks, dip pens and granulation medium available to use. Own reference material, photos of textures in landscapes, seascapes, rocks, cliffs, trees, foliage, etc. Bring your own packed lunch and drink.
